1 Kookootonga Walnut and Chestnut Farm C2

247 Mt Irvine Rd, Mt Irvine 02 4756 2136
Beautiful, scenic 60 ha farm, established Walnut and Chestnut grove. Special setting to collect own nuts, buckets, bags provided, ample road parking. 55km from Richmond on Hwy 40, turn right to Mt Wilson, left at Mt Irvine T junction, 1 km along sealed road. Mid March-late April 9.00-5.00



2 Nutwood Farm C2

22 Danes Way, Mt Irvine 02 4756 2191
Pick your own chestnuts. Established chestnut farm and walnuts (when available) in a beautiful setting. Children welcome. Level parking on property, 55km from Richmond on Hwy 40, turn right to Mt Wilson, left at Mt Irvine T junction, left again to Danes Way. Follow yellow Nutwood Farm signs for 2km exactly. Open: Mar-Apr Sat-Sun 10.00-5.00 (by app. during week).



3 Mount Tomah Botanic Garden B4

Be enchanted by this spectacular cold climate garden with panoramic views. See Wollemi Pines and displays of plants from around the world. Restaurant, weddings and gardens shop. Picnic/BBQ areas. Parking. Small entry fee. Open 7 days 10.00-4.00 (5pm daylight saving).
